Training Documentation Form

Training verification is an institutional responsibility to ensure that all personnel working with laboratory animals are properly qualified. The Animal Welfare Act states that "Training and instruction shall be made available, and the qualifications of personnel reviewed, with sufficient frequency to fulfill the research facilities responsibilities". Further, the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* notes that "Investigators, technical personnel, trainees, and visiting investigators who perform animal anesthesia, surgery or other experimental manipulations must be qualified through training or experience to accomplish these tasks in a humane and scientifically acceptable manner". Thus, satisfying the training requirements of the institution may be achieved by numerous methods.
